

**Northeast Ohio Athletic District Swimming Sectionals**

**Canton Sectional at C.T. Branin Natatorium**

**LOCATION:**

C.T. Branin Natatorium, 1715 Harrison Ave NW, Canton, OH 44708

**DATE:**

Boys and Girls will swim on Saturday, February 10, 2018. They will swim together as one session.

**START TIMES:**

Warm ups: 7:30 am – 8:55 am

Meet will begin at 9:00 am.

Doors for swimmers and coaches will open at 7:00 am

**SPECTATOR SEEDING:**

Doors for spectators will open at 7:30 am

**COACHES' MEETING:**

There will not be a coaches' meeting prior to the meet.

**SCRATCHES:**

- All scratches must be done immediately upon your arrival at the computer table and no later than one hour before the start of the session, including relay names.

**RELAYS:**

- Any relay changes must be done before the event at the scorer's table.

**TIES:**

- All ties through 16th place must be resolved. The coaches will be summoned and the tie can be broken through swim off, coin flip, or concession.

**FACILITIES**

- The pool is eight lanes, 25 yards long
- Swimmers are not allowed in the area immediately behind the starting block area unless they are competing in the event in the water or the event on call. Please keep this area as clear as possible for the timers and officials
- Coaches and swimmers need to remain quiet at the start keep the areas clear for the officials
- Only swimmers entered in the meet, coaches, meet workers, and officials are permitted on the deck. It will be up to coaches to monitor swimmers
- Wristbands must be worn by coaches to be permitted on deck and for admittance into hospitality
- Only volunteers wearing wristbands will be permitted on deck during the meet
- All teams/swimmers entered in the meet must sit on the pool deck or in the south stands by the record board
- Swimmers entered in the meet will NOT be permitted to sit in the stands
- The gym will be open/set up for rub down tables and for swimmers to relax
- The girls and boys locker rooms will be available for the girls and boys, respectively
- We are not responsible for personal belongings
- Coaches are responsible for seeing their team areas and locker rooms are left clean at the end of the meet
- NO glass containers on the pool deck, please
- There will be no shaving down in the facility

**ENTRIES:**

- Entries should be electronic on Hy-Tek Team Manager
- Electronic entries must be e-mailed to Sarah Tobin at [ccsmeetentries@gmail.com](mailto:ccsmeetentries@gmail.com) by noon on Monday, February 5, 2018
- Please refer to the OHSAA web site for the entry guideline sheet
- All coaches must be listed in your electronic entry or they will not be allowed on deck at Districts
- Each team is allowed up to 4 entries in each individual event
- Teams are allowed one relay per event

- **Divers must be included on the Hy-Tek entry**

- Contestants are allowed to enter a maximum of four events (no more than two individuals).
- Being listed on a relay does not count as an event until the swimmer actually swims the event.
- All swimmers entered in Sectionals must be listed on the OHSAA Eligibility Form, including relay-only swimmers
- Divers enter a six dive score
- **Entries are due NOON on Monday, February 5, 2018.** Entries may be turned in earlier as it would help with the clerical work. Be sure to include USA number for any USA swimmer.

There shall be a minimum of a 15 minute time period from the start of consecutive same gender events in the post-season tournament. This would mean the Girls 200 Freestyle would start no earlier than 15 minutes after the start of the Girls Medley Relay, etc. This will proceed throughout the tournament. There will be one additional 15 minute break after the Boys 50 Freestyle.

#### **MEDICAL FORMS:**

Please make sure you have all medical forms with you for all of your swimmers and divers during completion.

- For any and all swimmers using the kinesis/medical tape, you must have the properly signed documentation. It would be advisable to give the referee a copy of the slip and you can keep the original for use at the next level of competition.

#### **CONDUCT:**

Absolutely **NO** speakers will be permitted in the pool area. Remember, OHSAA rules prohibit balloons and banners other than team banners to be displayed. Banners may not obstruct spectators view.

#### **DIVING:**

#### **SCRATCHES FOR DISTRICTS:**

If you have an automatic qualifier that cannot swim at districts, you **MUST** scratch them at the conclusion of your sectional session before the results are sent to Pam Cook. There will be NO reseeding at the district meet after the results are sent. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### **USA OBSERVATION:**

This meet will be USA observed; therefore, all USA Swimming registered athletes times will be uploaded to SWIMS. Please make sure you have USA Swimming ID # in the database to insure that the times are uploaded. If you are unsure, please email Sarah Tobin.

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
