

# Northeast Ohio Athletic District Swimming Sectionals

## Division I, Section II

### Mayfield High School at SPIRE

### February 10, 2018

**WHERE:** The meet will be held at SPIRE, 5201 SPIRE Circle, Geneva, OH 44041

**WHEN:** Boys and Girls will swim on Saturday, February 10, 2018. They will swim together as one session.

**START TIMES:** Warm-up: 10:00 to 11:30 am  
Meet will begin at 11:35 am.

**COACHES' MEETING:** There will not be a coaches' meeting prior to the meet.

#### SCRATCHES:

- All scratches must be done immediately upon your arrival at the computer table and no later than one hour before the start of the session, including relay names.
- Swimmers need to notify timers of relay order at the block.

#### FACILITIES:

- The pool is ten lanes, 25 yards long, numbered zero to 9
- No swimmers are allowed on the bulkhead except for one counter per lane during the 500 free
- Swimmers are not allowed in the area immediately behind the starting block area unless they are competing in the event in the water or the event on call. Please keep this area as clear as possible for the timers and officials
- Coaches and swimmers need to remain quiet at the start keep the areas clear for the officials
- Only coaches, swimmers, meet workers, and officials should be on the deck. It will be up to coaches to monitor swimmers
- Wristbands must be worn by coaches to be permitted on deck and for admittance into hospitality
- Only volunteers wearing a deck pass will be permitted on deck during the meet
- The girls and boys locker rooms will be available for the girls and boys, respectively
- We are not responsible for personal belongings
- Coaches are responsible for seeing their team areas and locker rooms are left clean at the end of the meet
- NO glass containers on the pool deck, please
- There will be no shaving down allowed in the facility

#### ENTRIES:

- Entries should be electronic on Hy-Tek Team Manager
- Electronic entries should be e-mailed to Frank Campbell at [frankacampbell@gmail.com](mailto:frankacampbell@gmail.com)
- Please refer to the OHSAA web site for the entry guideline sheet
- All coaches must be listed in your electronic entry or they will not be allowed on deck at Districts
- Each team is allowed up to 4 entries in each individual event
- Teams are allowed one relay per event. Up to 8 swimmers may be listed for each relay. Changes may be made the day of the meet, up to one hour before the start of the session.
- Divers must be included on the entry—Must be entered in Hy-Tek and eDive
- Contestants are allowed to enter a maximum of four events (no more than two individuals).
- Being listed on a relay does not count as an event until the swimmer actually swims the event.
- All swimmers entered in Sectionals must be listed on the OHSAA Eligibility Form, including relay-only swimmers
- Divers enter a six dive score
- **Entries are due NOON on Monday, February 5, 2018.** Entries may be turned in earlier as it would help with the clerical work. Be sure to include USA number for any USA swimmer.
- **Entry confirmation due Tuesday, February 6 by 12:00 PM:** Frank will email your team's entry. Please confirm that there are no scratches and/or changes.

- **According to OHSAA Guidelines, psych sheets will be made available on Wednesday February 7, 2018.**
- Ties will be broken up to 16 places. Breaking ties may be done by swim-off, coin toss or deferring to the opponent.

**There shall be a minimum of a 15-minute time period from the start of consecutive same gender events in the post-season tournament. This would mean the Girls 200 Freestyle would start no earlier than 15-minutes after the start of the Girls Medley Relay, etc. This will proceed throughout the tournament. There will be one additional 15-minute break after the Boys 50 Freestyle.**

**MEDICAL FORMS:** Please make sure you have all medical forms with you for all of your swimmers and divers during competition.

**CONDUCT:** Absolutely **NO** speakers or noisemakers will be permitted in the pool area. Remember, OHSAA rules prohibit balloons and banners other than team banners to be displayed. Banners may not obstruct spectators view.

**DIVING:** All diving information will be sent to the swim coaches.

Saturday, February 10, 2018:

- Meet begins at 11:35 am
- Girls and boys will swim together, alternately in the deep end of the pool (opposite the scoreboard)
- Admissions: \$6.00 adults/seniors, \$4.00 students
- Heat Sheets: \$3.00 heats
- Parking is free

**SCRATCHES FOR DISTRICTS:** If you have an automatic qualifier that cannot swim at districts, you **MUST** scratch them at the conclusion of your sectional session before the results are sent to Pam Cook. There will be NO reseeding at the district meet after the results are sent. Thank you for your cooperation.

**USA OBSERVATION:** All Sectional, District and State meet will be USA observed meets.
